Grooming space/extra dbl cage - \$40 each double space

Sponsorship - \$25 per ring, \$100 all rings. No limit in each ring.

Junior Exhibitors: The Junior Exhibitor ring is open to anyone under 18 years old.

Only one entry per Junior and he/she must show the cat unless they are helping with the show such as steward.

Early Bird Entries: All EB entries must be paid by close of EB to retain that rate.

Regular Entries: All regular entries must be paid by close of entries on **Tuesday July 9 at 12:00 pm (Noon) Eastern** (show closing). Cash or check at door will be accepted with a \$10 surcharge and you must inform the entry clerk that you will be paying at the door.

By entering the show with your placeholder or entry in TOES you agree to pay the club the monies due, enter your cat at your own risk, to abide by and uphold the Rules of The International Cat Association, to abide by the rulings of the Show Committee, to understand that a phone/fax/e-mail entry constitutes an agreement to pay for

entries even if you fail to bench or withdraw from the show. **THERE WILL BE NO REFUNDS after your entry has been accepted.** Once your entry has been received only substitutions may be made for a fee. Payment options: you may pay by Paypal or by mailing a check payable to Buckeye Ohio Rollers c/o Nancy Schuman covering the expenses for your entries as posted on the Summary Form for this show within 5 working days to the Entry Clerk, that there is a \$25 returned check fee and if you have any changes you will contact the Entry Clerk via e-mail or phone immediately.

Kitten/cats for sale are allowed accompanying entered kittens/cats. Remember that show rules specify no more than 2 adults, or 1 adult and 2 kittens, or 4 kittens, per double space.

Camp Sites:

Sites for campers are available on the fairgrounds fairly close to the show hall at \$25.00 per day. This includes your water, electric hookup and access to the dump station.

Camping is managed by the Wayne County Agricultural Society.

Health Info

This is a non-vetted show. All cats and kittens must be current on vaccinations, and free of all parasites, fungus, and illness. Any cat or kitten from a household where there has been fungus, parasites, or any contagious or infectious illness within 21 days prior to the opening date of the show is ineligible for entry. Cats showing any sign of illness, parasites or fungus will not be permitted in the show hall. All cats or kittens accompanying said cat(s) will also be dismissed from the show hall. Cats which are pregnant or lactating will be ineligible from competition.

Show Services

The Club will provide litter. You must bring your own litter pans, cat food and dishes. People food will be available.

Cage Sizes

A double cage is approximately 22" x 22" x 44". All cages are assigned; we will try to honor your benching request. No one may change their benching assignment per order of the Show Management. Cages must be covered on all three sides, top and bottom. Only one cat or two kittens are permitted per single cage.

Junior Exhibitors

Buckeye Ohio Rollers is pleased to recognize our Junior Exhibitor participants and extend a special entry fee rate includes a double space for one entry registered in their name. Please note on the entry in TOES if this is a JE entry. Only one per child.

Awards will be provided in accordance with TICA Show Rules. We do have Supreme Rosettes - if your cat Supremes at our show, please see a member of the show committee for your rosette.

Clerks & Stewards are Needed!

Please contact the Entry Clerk if you are able to clerk and/or steward. Fees will be paid according to time spent as a clerk at the show, and preference will be given to TICA licensed clerks.
